

## Quebec amends basic drug plan

Quebec has made some changes to the out-of-pocket maximum and co-insurance amounts for its basic drug plan. The changes, effective **July 1, 2010**, affect plan sponsors who provide drug coverage to Quebec plan members.

Legislative change	Drug claims for Quebec plan members
Increase in annual out-of-pocket maximum to <b>\$963</b> from <b>\$954</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Drug claims from Quebec plan members will now be subject to the new out-of-pocket maximum of <b>\$963</b></li> </ul>
Co-insurance (amount RAMQ pays) remains the same at <b>68%</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>No change</b> - drug claims continue to be paid at <b>68%</b></li> </ul>

We're in the process of updating our systems to reflect this change. There will be no immediate rate adjustments due to the changes and we expect minimal impact on claim experience.
