

Quebec amends its public drug plan

Every year, Quebec revises the amounts related to its public drug plan. As of **July 1, 2017**, changes have been made to the out-of-pocket maximum and co-insurance amounts. These [changes](#) affect plan sponsors who provide drug coverage to plan members residing in Quebec.

Legislative changes	Drug claims for Quebec plan members
Increase in annual out-of-pocket maximum to \$1,066 from \$1,046	Drug claims from plan members residing in Quebec for drugs listed on the RAMQ formulary will now be subject to the new annual out-of-pocket maximum of \$1,066
Decrease in co-insurance (amount RAMQ pays) to 65.2% from 65.5%	Drug claims from plan members residing in Quebec for drugs listed on the RAMQ formulary will now be subject to the new minimum co-insurance amount of 65.2%

We are in the process of updating our systems to reflect these changes. There will be no immediate rate adjustments due to the changes and we expect minimal impact on plan members and on claim experience.
